340B PROGRAM BASICS

US federal government program created in 1992 Administered by
the Health
Resources and
Services
Administration
(HRSA), Office of
Pharmacy Affairs
(OPA)

Requires drug
manufacturers
participating in
Medicare and
Medicaid to sell
outpatient drugs to
safety net
providers at
significantly
reduced prices

340B PROGRAM INTENT

Support mission

Stretch Federal funds

Use drug savings to benefit more patients

Provide more comprehensive services

PROGRAM PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Meet definition of a Covered Entity

Capacity to follow (and maintain audible records documenting compliance with) program rules

Register on the HRSA 340B database

Recertify with HRSA annually


